SPENCES BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

BY-ELECTION

The Spences Bridge Improvement District is a defined service area in the unincorporated community of Spences Bridge that has the governance authority to fund the operations of the Spences Bridge Volunteer Fire Department and the operations of the Spences Bridge community streetlight.

The Spences Bridge Improvement District is governed by a Board of three Improvement District Trustees elected to represent the service area. The Improvement District is seeking individuals to fill two vacant Improvement District Trustee positions.

A by-election will be held Tuesday, July 18, 2017. The voting poll located at the Improvement District Administration Office, 4800 School Street, will be open for voting between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. and again between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

NOTICE OF CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Those individuals interested and qualifying to hold office in the Spences Bridge Improvement District may request a nomination package by contacting the Spences Bridge Improvement District By-election Returning Officer at 250-719-1956 or fbanham@explornet.ca.

Candidates letting their name stand for 'Trustee' for the Spences Bridge Improvement District must be:

- I. A Canadian Citizen;
- II. 18 years of age or older as per the *BC Elections ACT*;
- III. Be an owner of land located within the defined area identified as the Spences Bridge Improvement District;
- IV. A resident of BC for the past 6 months;
- V. Not otherwise be disqualified by law from voting.

Nominations close at 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 11th, 2017. A full and complete candidate nomination package must be received by the Spences Bridge Improvement District By-election Returning Officer between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Tuesday July 11th, 2017 at the Spences Bridge Administration offices located at 4800 School Street, Spences Bridge, BC.

Two Trustees will be elected. The candidate with the most votes shall serve for two years and the candidate with the second most votes shall serve for one year.
