

THOMPSON-NICOLA REGIONAL DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 2087

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEM SERVICE WITHIN A PORTION OF ELECTORAL AREA "I" (BLUE SKY COUNTRY)

WHEREAS a Regional District may, by bylaw, establish and operate a service under the provisions of Part 24 of the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the Board of Directors has been petitioned, in accordance with Section 797.4 of the *Local Government Act*, by the owners of parcels from within a portion of Electoral Area "I" (Blue Sky Country);

AND WHEREAS the Clerk has certified the petition as sufficient meeting the requirements of Section 797.4 (3) of the *Local Government Act* and Section 212 (4) through (6) of the *Community Charter*.

AND WHEREAS the Board of Directors has authorized approval pursuant to Section 801.5 (1) of the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the Director of Electoral Area "I" (Blue Sky Country) has consented in writing to the adoption of this bylaw pursuant to Section 801.5 (2) of the *Local Government Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Thompson-Nicola Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. CITATION

- 1.1 This bylaw may be cited as the "Spences Bridge Community Water System Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 2087, 2006".

2. SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT

- 2.1 There is hereby established a community water system service area within a portion of Electoral Area "I" (Blue Sky Country).

3. AUTHORITY

- 3.1 The Board of Directors of the Thompson-Nicola Regional District is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out, or cause to be undertaken and carried out, provision of a Community Water System as a service, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to:

- (a) acquire all such licenses, rights or authorities as may be required or desirable for or in connection with the provision of the Spences Bridge Community Water System service; and

- (b) enter into contracts with such authorities and companies as may be necessary or appropriate to implement, maintain and operate the Spences Bridge Community Water System.

4. PARTICIPATING AREA

- 4.1 The participant in the service, established under Section 2, is a portion of Electoral Area "I" (Blue Sky Country).
- 4.2 The boundaries of the service area, to be known as the "Spences Bridge Community Water System Service Area" are as shown on Schedule A" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

5. COST RECOVERY

- 5.1 The annual cost of providing the service established in Section 2 of this bylaw shall be recovered by:
- (a) the requisition of money under Section 803(1)(b) of the *Local Government Act* as a parcel tax to be imposed in the manner provided by Section 806.1 (1) (b) of the *Local Government Act* for the purpose of recovering debt servicing costs and other administration fees, and
- (b) the imposition of fees and other charges for the purpose of recovering administrative, maintenance, connection, reconnection, operating costs and debenture payments.
- 5.2 The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the service under Section 806 of the *Local Government Act* shall not exceed Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00)

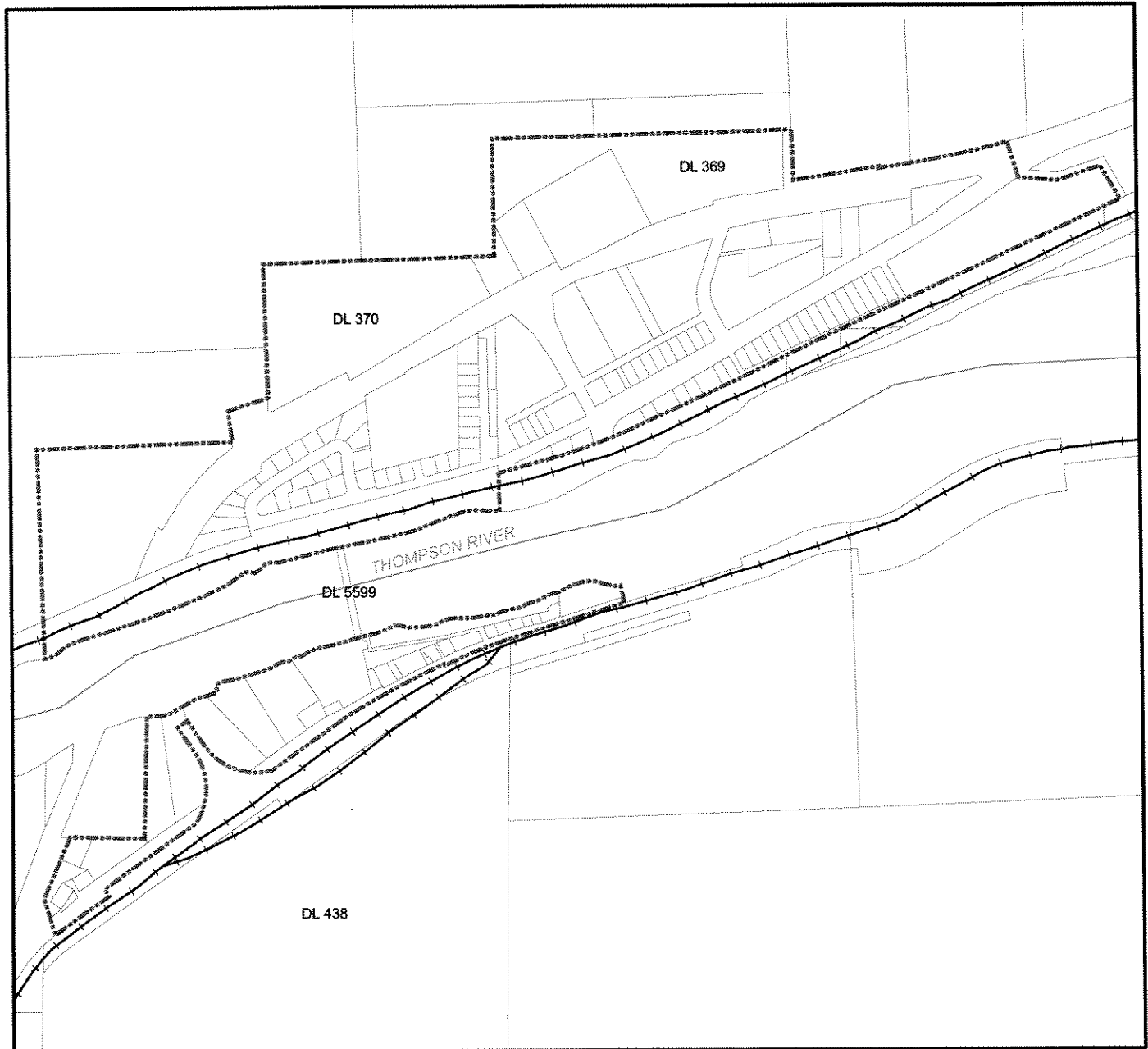

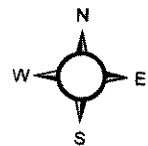
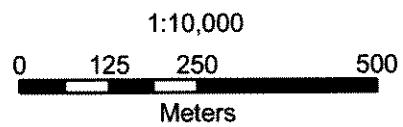
